Committees

The Chairperson (and Co-Chairperson) of all committees and clubs are residents who have volunteered to assume the responsibility for their committee or club. A Board member also serves as a liaison to each committee.

- The **Clubhouse Committee** checks the clubhouse, reports problems with the building or clubhouse grounds that they have observed and may provide some repairs.
- The Architectural Review Committee has the responsibility for reviewing the requests and plans any resident has for modification to the exterior of their home or grounds.
- The Lifestyle Committee meets monthly to plan activities for the community social, educational topical meetings, and family events. Lifestyle also sponsors regular community socials at the clubhouse. Each has a theme and are open to all adult residents. All activities have one or two residents who are responsible for each event. The Ridings Greeters reach out to new residents to welcome them to The Ridings and to provide newcomers with pertinent information about the community and the surrounding area.
